ENERGY STAR® to Label Commercial Dishwashers

ENERGY STAR (a joint program of the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency and the U.S. Department of Energy, was developed to help consumers and businesses save money and protect the environment through energy efficient products and practices), has developed guidelines for commercial high and low temperature [undercounter dishwashers](#), [stationary single tank dishwashers](#), [single tank conveyor dishwashers](#), and [multiple tank](#) dishwashers.

The guidelines requires that commercial high temperature sanitizing and commercial chemical sanitizing dishmachines meet stringent guidelines on water usage and idle energy usage.

What can ENERGY STAR qualified commercial dishwashers save me?

Each ENERGY STAR qualified commercial dishwashers can save businesses energy about 93 MBtus annually, or an average of \$850/year on utility bills. Besides using energy, commercial dishwashers also consume water during operation. By purchasing products that meet the new ENERGY STAR criteria, consumers can expect to save more than \$200/year and 52,000 gallons/year due to reduced water usage.
